

AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

WHEREAS the Ministry of Habitat, Planning and Environment of the Republic of the Djibouti and the Italian Ministry for the Environment, Land and Sea (IMELS), hereafter referred to as “the Signatories”, have signed a Memorandum of Understanding on cooperation in the field of climate change vulnerability, risk assessment, adaptation and mitigation on November 17, 2016;

WHEREAS the Signatories wish to amend the abovementioned Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), to include the possibility to grant additional financing for the implementation of projects and activities under the MOU;

WHEREAS Article 9 of the MOU provides that the Signatories may amend the MOU by a written agreement signed by the Signatories;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, the Signatories agree as follows:

1. A new comma 4 is added to **Article 6 “Means of Implementation”**, namely:

6.4 Wherever there is a need to increase the global amount set in paragraph 6.1, IMELS may decide to grant additional financing. Should it take such a decision, IMELS will inform the Ministry of Habitat, Planning and Environment of the Republic of the Djibouti about the additional amount provided, in the occasion of the Joint Committee.

Funds will be issued according to the same terms and conditions set out in the Financial Document.

2. This Amendment becomes effective on the date of its signature and may be amended only in accordance with the provisions of the MoU.

3. As modified by this Amendment, the MoU shall continue in full force and effect in accordance with its terms.


4. This Amendment shall be governed by and construed and enforced in accordance with the provisions of **Article 8 “Law in force”**.
